Bannon's face is white as a sheet - absolute horror written over his countenance.

KNOX (CONT'D)

I dragged Mr. Haven from the house, where he had been shot twice. She made me help her bury the bodies.

(beat)

I was given \$100 dollars to drive Mrs. Haven to the Williston train station. And she told me to make a contract for the farm. And sign it from Albert.

Now we see Jacobson - disbelief and absolute rage running across his face.

KNOX (CONT'D)

promised I would not tell. Signed,  
Charles Bannon.

Knox lowers the letters and looks with grim smugness at Taylor.
